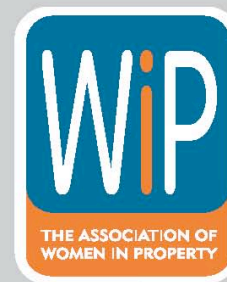

Community Engagement with 3G Communications

Developers, including the public sector, have increasing obligations to involve communities in national decisions - such as airports, power stations and roads. Communities are more demanding, and they expect to be involved in decisions that affect them and will challenge the decision making process.

The new Infrastructure Planning Commission can reject a nationally significant scheme if consultation has not been rigorous, and there is insufficient evidence of communities having been involved in decision making.
