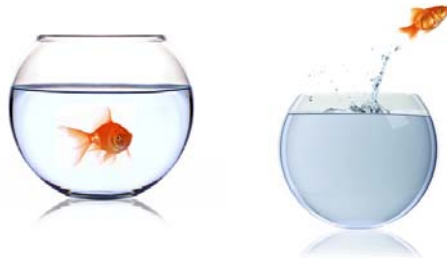


BREAKING NEWS – An update on recent case law on break notices
