The Duchy of Cornwall's, Nansledan School (Skol Nansledan in Cornish) is a brand new school that will cater for 420 children, operated by the Aspire Academy Trust which already supports 25 primary school academies across Cornwall. Due to open in September 2019, it aims to nurture intelligent, employable global citizens who demonstrate social competence, a desire for learning and respect for each other and the world around them. Designed by Francis Robert Architects and Alan Leather Associates, this school will offer a state of the art learning facility within an iconic building. The grounds of the school will help reinforce the sustainability ethos of Nansledan and include an orchard and allotments. Other facilities will include sports pitches, an outdoor play and teaching areas.
