Wapping Wharf Phase 2 Development Site Visit

Wednesday 23rd January 2019 8:00AM-10AM Wapping Wharf, Wapping Road, Bristol, BS1 4RW

The Association of Women in Property, Balfour Beatty, Hydrock and Alec French Architects would like to invite you to a site visit of the major redevelopment of Wapping Wharf Phase 2.

Following completion of Phase 1 (Blocks A, B and C), Phase 2, located to the east of the site adjacent to Wapping Road, comprises Blocks D and E: five to six- storey independent buildings accommodating retail units, semi-basement car park and upper floor residential units. Phase 2 works also include the restoration of The Old City Gaol gatehouse, which will be used as an entrance to Wapping Wharf development.

There will be a brief multidisciplinary introduction of the scheme followed by a site visit and chance to network over breakfast, courtesy of Balfour Beatty.

Important: all delegates will need to wear 5point PPE consisting of boots, Hi-vis vest, safety helmet, gloves and glasses (anyone without this please advise shoe size at time of booking on the form below).
