Cyber-crime is a multi-billion pound global industry and no company, however small, can afford to assume “it won’t happen to us”. Non-executive directors and Trustees need to be aware of the types of threats that exist, such as ransomware, brute force and the more familiar DDOS; as well as the huge part that social engineering plays in cyber breaches. They also need to have insight into the questions that the board should be asking the executives in this area, such as:

- Can you confirm that all employees have cyber-security training at least once a year?
- Are we working towards certification under the UK Government’s Cyber Essentials scheme? (If not, why not?)
- Have we reviewed our supply chain to understand how their access to our networks might compromise our security? Or how failures in our own systems could threaten organisations with whom we work?
