# Panorama Place Site Visit

Panorama Place, 31 Gloucester Rd, Almondsbury, Bristol BS32 4HH

This site visit is to possibly one of the best views across the Severn estuary, over to Wales. Panorama Place is an exclusive development by Alexander James Cox Ltd of three, four bedroom, high spec homes, cut into a steep slope, with integral garages, and balconies on two levels. Constructed with Durisol, to speed up the build, pre-insulated interlocking blocks are dry-stacked together, and filled with concrete to form walls. The units are thermally insulated non-combustible, durable, absorb sound, and have U & PSI values which exceed cavity & timber frame buildings. There will be a technical presentation by RISE Structures Director Ingrid Chauvet and project engineer Scott Temple. Tea/coffee and snacks provided. **PPE required to gain site access (Head protection, foot protection, body protection, and Hi-Vis).** Due to limited spaces on this site, there is a maximum of two bookings per company.
