Leeds student crowned national winner

Eunice John, a Leeds Beckett University student, has won the top prize in the 2019 Women in Property National Student Awards. Studying Architectural Technology, Eunice triumphed over 13 other national finalists and 137 regional contenders in the annual competition which celebrates the best of the best built environment degree students from across the UK.

The Student Awards highlight to industry the necessity to link with universities early in the education process and also improve the students' knowledge of the career options available to them. Many secure work placements as a direct result of competing in the Awards, which often translate into permanent positions upon graduation. Eunice has secured a placement with SMR Architects in Harrogate.



The awards are judged by representatives from the three national sponsors, Bouygues UK, Linden Homes and Savills, and the National Chairman of Women in Property, Mandy St John Davey. Eunice was described by the judges as being "very grounded; genuine; a very warm individual. We were struck by her passion and humility, she has 'the X Factor', a can-do attitude and will make an amazing ambassador for women in property and construction.".

Family-friendly bat walk



Bat ecologist Faye Davies from Ecus in Sheffield led a Women in Property guided bat walk through Millhouses Park and shared information and facts about bats such as where they live, what they eat and what great mums they are!

Bats can live for around 40 years and the UK's most common bat the pipistrelle weighs the same as a 20p coin and yet can eat up to 3000 midges per evening! Using bat detectors, which turn the bats' echolocation calls into a sound that humans can hear, the group could hear the bats' feeding on insects, and watched them flying over the river.
