Many of the councils that we work with have declared a climate emergency, and to support them in this, we are particularly keen to strengthen the sustainability and climate change expertise that our panels offer. As well as looking for experts with an engineering background, we are keen to hear from architects and urban designers who can demonstrate a track record of innovation in low carbon design.
