Travel

In the interest of sustainable travel, the venue is a 20-minute walk from Bristol Temple Meads train station and is also served from Temple Meads by Bus no. 70 or 73.

Accommodation

Site Studies

To continue the learning and networking opportunities, on the morning of Friday 21st April there will be a number of high-profile site study tours in and around the City. These tours (maximum of one per delegate) are included in the conference ticket price - you will be asked to express a preference on which tour you would like to attend when booking.

Halo 1 Temple Street, Redcliffe, Bristol, BS1 6EU

Recently completed in the heart of Finzel's Reach, and now undergoing tenant fit out, Halo is marketed as one of the UK's most sustainable office buildings. Come and tour the completed building and hear directly from the agents and new occupier.

SAP 3 *University of the West of England, Frenchay Campus, BS16 1QY* (Transport will be provided from the city centre)

Currently on site, this £70m 900 bed student accommodation project designed by Stride Treglown is believed to be one of the largest Passivhaus developments currently in progress. Take a tour of the live site and hear directly from the design team and contractor.

Amazon Avonmouth, BS11 OYH (Transport will be provided from the city centre)

Come and see this huge fulfilment centre in action, and hear directly from the team that delivered it, and work within it.

One Portwall Square One Portwall Lane, Redcliffee, Bristol, BS1 6BH

One Portwall Square is a new-build office for independent developer Nord on a site close to Bristol Temple Meads Railway Station. Hear directly from AHMM, who are both the architects and occupiers.

Temple Quarter Enterprise Campus

The Sheds will be the first buildings of the University of Bristol's Temple Quarter Enterprise Campus (TQEC) masterplan to complete. The masterplan aims to regenerate a large post-industrial site near Temple Meads. This is a light touch refurbishment project, delivering an academic building to house the Bristol Digital Futures Institute and their partners. The first phase, Retort House, has completed with the second phase, the Coal Shed, due to complete in October 2023. Come and see the progress and hear directly from the architect.
